

Directions

Edgar Glenn Public Landing –Lemon Island

From the intersection of US 278 and SC 170...

- Take SC 170 East. You will pass Oldfield on the right and the junction for SC 462 on the left after about 4 miles, stay on 170.
- After about 7.7 miles you will pass the Callawassie Island exit which has a traffic light.
- After a total of 9.3 miles you should see a landing on the right. Turn right onto Echotango Rd. If you cross the Chechessee River you have gone too far.

Bolan Hall Landing

From the intersection of US 278 and SC 170...

- Take SC 170 about 4 miles to SC 462 West which is a **left** turn off 170.
- Proceed about another 6 miles on SC 462 past Waste Management/ Hickory Hill Landfill on the left and Marsh Cove and Green Place on the right.
- Look for a brown sign with Bolan Hall Landing on it. The Second Euhaw Missionary Baptist Church is on the left.
- Turn right at Bolan Landing Road and continue down the road to the end.

“The Sands” Boat Landing—Sands Beach area

From the intersection of US 278 and SC 170...

- Take SC 170 East toward Beaufort. (SC 170 is also marked Robert Smalls Parkway).
- After about 14.5 miles you will encounter SC 802 East (also called Savannah Highway). Turn right onto 802 East.
- Proceed about 3.2 miles where you will cross the Russell Bell Bridge over Battery Creek. At this point the road is named Ribaut Road.
- After another 1.4 miles turn Right onto West Paris Avenue. You should see a sign indicating “Port Royal Access”. Follow this road through the left and right jog at the stop sign. The road is now marked Paris Avenue. (The other part of the “Y” is the East portion.)
- Paris Avenue continues past the Port Royal Elementary School and various small shops. It dead-ends at the South Carolina Port Authority Buildings and you must turn left onto the one-way street (7th Street).
- 7th Street becomes Sands Beach Road after the stop sign. Follow this road to the end.
- Trip length from US 278 and SC 170 about 20.4 miles

Broad River Landing & Fishing Pier

From the intersection of US 278 and SC 170

Take SC 170 East. You will pass Oldfield on the right and the turn for SC 462 on the left after about 4 miles.

- After about 7.7 miles you will pass the Callawassie Island exit which has a traffic light.
- After a total of 9.3 miles you should cross the Chechessee River with the Edgar Glenn Landing on the right and Lemon Island Marina on the left. Keep going.
- At a distance of about 14.5 miles from the intersection of US 278 and SC 170 you will cross the Broad River and come to the intersection of SC 170 and SC 802 where you will turn left.
- The left turn is onto a frontage road going back towards the bridge. Follow it to the landing.

Lady's Island—White Hall Landing

From the intersection of US 278 and SC 170...

- Take SC 170 East toward Beaufort. (SC 170 is also marked Robert Smalls Parkway).
- After about 14.5 miles you will encounter SC 802 East (also called Savannah Highway). Turn right onto 802 East.
- Proceed about 3.2 miles where you will cross the Russell Bell Bridge over Battery Creek. At this point the road is named Ribaut Road.
- Stay on SC 802 East for another 3.6 miles until it intersects with Business 21 (Sea Island Parkway). Turn left.
- About 1 mile further on the right you will see a sign for Lady's Island Landing.

Pigeon Point Landing

From the intersection of US 278 and SC 170...

- Take SC 170 East. You will pass Oldfield on the right and the turn for SC 462 on the left after about 4 miles. Stay on 170.
- After about 7.7 miles you will pass the Callawassie Island exit which has a traffic light.
- After a total of 9.3 miles you should cross the Chechessee River with the Edgar Glenn Landing on the right and Lemon Island Marina on the left. Keep going.
- At a distance of about 14.5 miles from the intersection of US 278 and SC 170 you will cross the Broad River and come to the intersection of SC 170 and SC 802.
- Stay on SC 170. After another 3.2 miles you'll go through the intersection of SC 170 and SC 280. Again stay on SC 170.
- Continue for another 1.7 miles to the intersection of SC 170 and US 21 (Boundary Street). Turn right.
- Proceed about 2.4 miles to Pigeon Point Road and turn left. The Pigeon Point Landing is about 1 mile down the road.

New River Landing

- Take SC 170 West to SC 46.
- Turn right onto SC 170/46
- New River Landing is on the right hand side just over the new bridge.

Cook's Landing

- Take SC 170 West to SC 46.
- Turn right onto SC 170/46
- You will see New River Landing on the right hand side just over the new bridge. Keep going.
- Continue for about another half mile until SC 170 and SC 46 split. Proceed to the left on SC 170 ALT past the BP station.
- Continue on SC 170 ALT about 2 miles further to Cook's Landing Road. Turn left and go to the end of the road.
